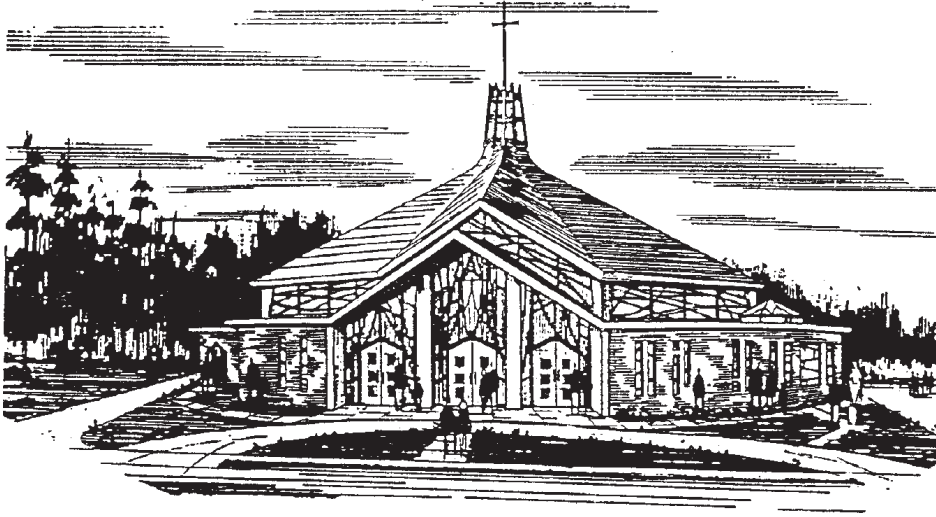

Message from the Pastor:

“Take it; this is my body.”
“This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many.”

Today, we celebrate Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In the Eucharistic feast, the gifts of bread and wine really and truly become the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Through this covenant of love, God draws us into His divine life and offers us food for our earthly pilgrimage to continue with faith and hope, confident in God’s ability to transform our weaknesses and sufferings into life and joy.

Next Friday, June 12th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. In the Prayer after Communion on that day we pray that we may also be “fervent with the fire of holy love” and be so drawn to Jesus that “we may learn to see Him in our neighbor.” Jesus’ Sacred Heart is an “open heart” offering love and life to every human being. I recommend reading St. John Paul II’s Letter on 100th Anniversary of the Consecration of the Human Race to the Divine Heart of Jesus on June 11, 1999. “On the occasion of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart and the month of June, I have often urged the faithful to persevere in the practice of this devotion, which “contains a message which in our day has an extraordinary timeliness”, because “an unending spring of life, giving hope to every person, has streamed precisely from the Heart of God’s Son, who died on the Cross. From the Heart of Christ crucified is born the new humanity redeemed from sin.”

On the following day, June 13th, we celebrate the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary and our own Parish Feast Day. After the 8 am Mass we will pray a special Rosary dedicated to our families and our Parish and also for persecuted Christians around the world. It was also St. John Paul II, who in the first year of his Pontificate in 1979, said in his Encyclical Letter “*Redemptor Hominis*”: “We can say that the mystery of the Redemption took shape beneath the heart of the Virgin of Nazareth when she pronounced her “fiat”. From then on, under the special influence of the Holy Spirit, this heart, the heart of both a virgin and a mother, has always followed the work of her Son and has gone out to all those whom Christ has embraced and continues to embrace with inexhaustible love.”

And lastly, speaking of our own celebrations, I would like to invite everyone to the 12:00 Noon Mass next Sunday, June 14th in honor of the twenty-fifth Anniversary of the Priesthood of Fr. Lou Molinelli, alumnus of our Parish, along with a light luncheon reception immediately following in our school gym. A special day indeed for us all - hope to see you there!
