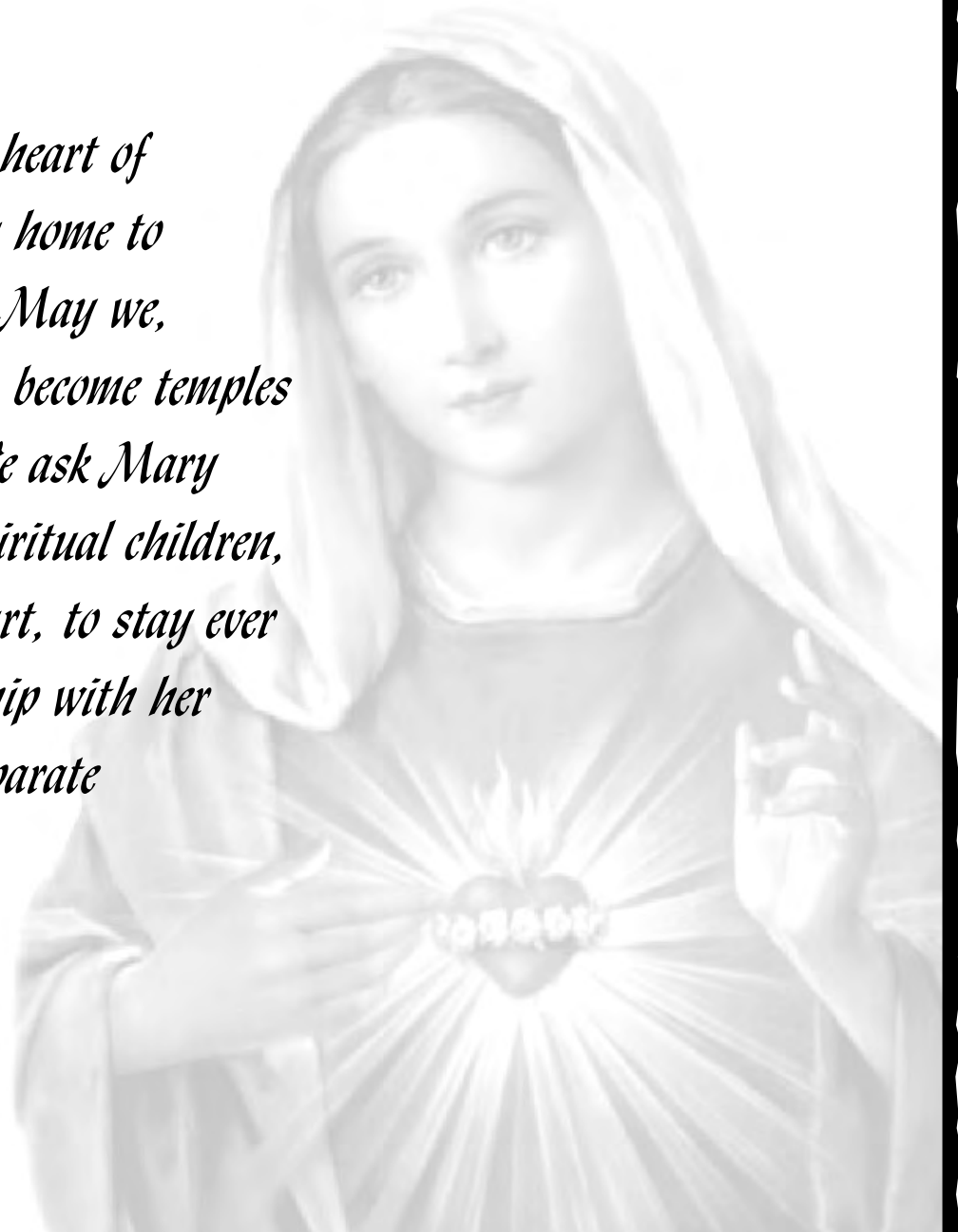


*Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us.*

## Message from the Pastor:

### ***“This is how it is with the kingdom of God...”***

“This is how it is,” Jesus says in Mark’s Gospel today. Yet there is no single way to describe the “kingdom of God.” Jesus uses two similar parables to teach us that the kingdom is realized in the intersection of our own work (planting the seed) with God’s work (the mystery of life growing and bearing fruit). The Good News is that God’s kingdom is assured - the scattered seed will yield a harvest; the tiny seed will grow into a large plant. “This is [really] how it is!” Like the farmer, we must do all we can do to provide the circumstances in which God’s reign can grow. When we do, all is ready for God’s Spirit to breathe life in our world, be it in the garden or our souls.

I would like to acknowledge and congratulate our new Eucharistic Ministers (properly named Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion). Through their devotion to the Eucharist and their desire to serve others in sharing the Sacred Banquet of our Lord they have gone through formal training both at the Archdiocese of Newark Office of Divine Worship and here at Immaculate Heart of Mary. Let us keep them in our prayers as they go forward in this ministry that is so vital to our Parish both at Mass and to the homebound and nursing homes as well.

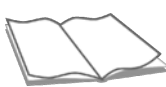
