

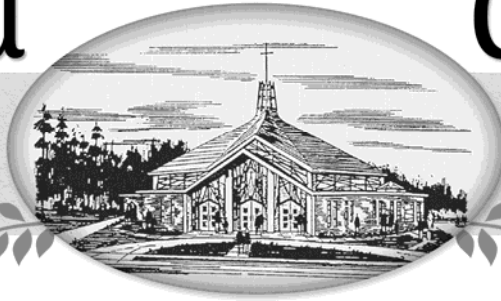

Message from the Pastor:

Today is World Mission Sunday. St. John Paul II described this day as "an important date in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give: as an offering made to God, in the Eucharistic celebration and for all the missions of the world." Every year the needs of the Catholic Church in the Missions grow - as new dioceses are formed; as new seminaries are opened due to the growing number of men hearing Christ's call to follow Him as priests; as areas devastated by war or natural disaster are rebuilt; and as other areas, long suppressed, are opening up to hear the message of Christ and His Church.

St. John Paul II was a great missionary. Driven by his pastoral solicitude for all Churches and by a sense of openness and charity to the entire human race, St. John Paul II exercised his Papal ministry with a tireless missionary spirit. During his Pontificate, he traveled to over 120 nations. This Thursday, October 22nd, we will celebrate the Feast of St. John Paul II. I am eternally grateful and honored to have received a primary relic of St. John Paul II for our Church from Cardinal Stanislaw Dziwisz of Krakow. We will have this on display this weekend in front of the sanctuary but it is our plan to design a permanent shrine to St. John Paul II in the alcove to the right of the Black Madonna icon. The painting of St. JPII has been donated for this shrine by Donna Kopcio. Additionally, the relic of St. John Bosco will also be shined in this alcove on the left side. As you know, both Saints had a great love and devotion to our Blessed Mother.

Moving to today's Gospel, Jesus teaches us by His own life and ministry that discipleship is not about seeking places of honor but about serving others. The tendency toward self-promotion is part of our human nature. Jesus teaches His disciples that it cannot be like that with them. He has come not to be served but to serve others, especially the poor and those who need healing. His greatness is seen most clearly in His laying down His life for others. Through Baptism we share in the Church's ministry to serve all who are in need. We share Christ's mission of working for peace and justice in our homes, our parish, and our world.

I would like to thank everyone who devoted so much of their time and talent in kicking off our Jubilee Celebration last Sunday – from Bishop Flesey who graced us with his presence in celebrating our Liturgy, to our team leaders and committee planners and doers, to our outstanding choir, altar servers, processional of parishioners who brought up the gifts including our lovely children, and lastly to our nonagenarians and all our parishioners who for the last hundred years made this parish what it is today. In the words of Bishop Flesey who concluded his homily with this: "And I say to you - accept the challenge. Continue to grow! The world needs this kind of a community NOW more than ever! God bless you on your journey!"
