

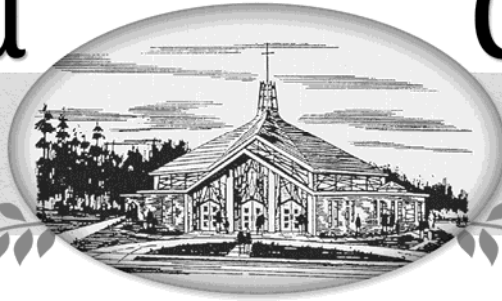

### Message from the Pastor:

Before these “lazy days” of summer quickly pass us by I want to continue reflecting on messages from Pope Francis at the recent World Youth Day to the Youth here in our Parish. “The times we live in do not call for young “couch potatoes” but for young people with shoes, or better, boots laced. It only takes players on the first string, and it has no room for bench-warmers. Today’s world demands that you be a protagonist of history because life is always beautiful when we choose to live it fully, when we choose to leave a mark. History today calls us to defend our dignity and not to let others decide our future. Today Jesus, who is the way, the truth and the life, is calling you to leave your mark on history. He, who is life, is asking each of you to leave a mark that brings life to your own history and that of many others. He, who is truth, is asking you to abandon the paths of rejection, division and emptiness. Are you up to this?”

So... beginning on Sunday, Sept. 18 at 6pm, and every Sunday thereafter, we will have a special Youth Mass for all our Youth, Teens and Young Adults with a Social Hour following! Our new Parish Catechetical Leader, Tim Malone, will orchestrate all activities surrounding this Mass and our Religious Education programs. Many of you already know Tim as a “lifelong” parishioner of our Parish and a prior student of our CCD programs. He is currently active as a Lector and Eucharistic Minister. Tim was President of the Catholic Campus Ministry Club at William Paterson University for three years and in 2014 was given the *Catholic Campus Minister of the Year Award* by the Diocese of Paterson. We wish Tim God’s Blessings and guidance as he embarks on his new position. We also wish to thank Barbara Dillon for her many years of service in teaching and guiding our Youth as she moves on to other ministries here in the Parish. To help get us started, there are Registration forms for all Youth to fill out in the Church lobby so we can properly prepare for this new ministry in responding to Pope Francis’ question “Are you up to this?” He closed his remarks at the Prayer Vigil with this: “When the Lord calls us, He doesn’t worry about what we are, what we have been, or what we have done or not done. Quite the opposite. When He calls us, He is thinking about everything we have to give, all the love we are capable of spreading. His bets are on the future, on tomorrow. Jesus is pointing you to the future, and never to the museum!”

Please see the insert in today’s Bulletin on the closing of our 100<sup>th</sup> Jubilee Celebration. We will begin in prayer and sacrifice with the Noon Mass, on Sunday, Sept. 25<sup>th</sup> with our special guest and main celebrant, Bishop Paul Bootkoski, ordained here in Newark and retired from the Diocese of Metuchen. The day will continue with a Gala Buffet at 2pm at the Sheraton Hotel in Mahwah. Registration forms must be completed and dropped off at the Rectory by Sept. 9<sup>th</sup>. I know everyone is looking forward to this special event in our history and will join all our parish community in praising and thanking God for our rich history of discipleship and in asking for His help and guidance as we navigate our paths in the days ahead.

In today’s Gospel, Jesus says “I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing.” He knows that His mission and ministry will bring opposition, rejection and suffering. Despite all this, Jesus is determined to be faithful throughout bringing to completion and fulfillment God’s Kingdom. As His disciples, we too, are challenged to take up the same mission and ministry!

## “Our Catholic Faith” “Feast of the Assumption”

The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, August 15, is the principal feast of the Blessed Virgin and has a double objective: (1) The happy departure of Mary from this life; and (2) the assumption of her body into heaven.

### The Fact of the Assumption

The dates assigned for the assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary vary between three and fifteen years after Christ’s Ascension. Two cities claim to be the place of her departure: Jerusalem and Ephesus. The belief in the corporal assumption of Mary is found on the apocryphal treatise **De Obitu S. Dominae**, bearing the name of St. John, which belongs to the fourth or fifth century. In writings in the East, it is mentioned in sermons of St. Andrew of Crete, St. John Damascene, St. Modestus of Jerusalem and others. In the West, St. Gregory of Tours mentions it first and St. John of Damascus formulates the tradition of the Church of Jerusalem. Today, the belief in the corporal assumption of Mary is universal in the East and the West.

### The Feast of the Assumption

Regarding the origin of the feast, we are also uncertain. It is more probably the anniversary of the dedication of some church than the actual anniversary of Our Lady’s death. According to the life of St. Theodosius (d. 529) it was celebrated in Palestine before the year 500, probably in August. In Egypt, Arabia and Rome, however, it was kept in January. In the Greek Empire the Emperor Maurice (d. 602) set the feast on August 15.

On November 1, 1950 Pope Pius XII declared infallibly that the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary was a dogma of the Catholic Faith in **Bull Munificentissimus Deus**. Likewise, the Second Vatican Council taught in the **Dogmatic Constitution Lumen Gentium** that “the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory when her earthly life was over, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things.
