

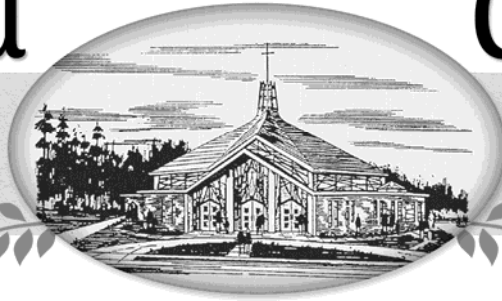

Message from the Pastor:

What a beautiful 100th Jubilee Closing Celebration it was! From the con-celebrated Mass with Bishop Paul Bootkoski as the main celebrant to the fun-filled Gala at the Sheraton we closed our year-long 100th Jubilee and began the next century in the life of our Church and Parish Community. There cannot be enough “thank yous” to **everyone** who participated in making, not only this day, but **all** the year-long events such special memories for our Parish. I’d like to give a special thank you to our Mayor, Bill Laforet, who spent the day with us and shared his heart-warming history with our community. He also was the winner of the 50/50 raffle and so graciously donated his winnings back to our Parish! Let us now march forward with Jesus, always by our side, with faith, hope, love, and forgiveness in our hearts, for the next 100 years!

In today’s Gospel of Luke, the disciples are concerned with their lack of faith. Jesus tells them that even a smidgen of faith can achieve great things. Jesus’ image of the mustard seed speaks of the quality of a commitment to their ministry rather than a concern for how much or how great the results are. The faithful disciple of Jesus is never finished serving. The faith of a disciple is never finished increasing!

Today we kick-off “**Respect Life**” Sunday as well as the month of October dedicated to the protection of human life. Prayer is the foundation of all that we do in defense of human life. Let us all pray and ask for God's [intercession](#) for those who have lost a child due to miscarriage, abortion or who are in conflict. Everyone can find a way to praise and thank God for the gift of life and to ask for protection for each sacred human life. There are many materials available on the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops’ website, [usccb.org](#), as well as our Archdiocese website, [rcan.org](#), on the Respect Life Program that can help Catholics understand, value, and become engaged with supporting the dignity of the human person, and therefore, the gift of every person's life. Kathy DiFiore, Founder of Several Sources Shelters, headquartered in Ramsey, NJ, will speak at all Masses on Sunday, Oct. 30th, on hope, assistance and shelter to pregnant teens, needy families and homeless women.

On Tuesday, September 20, 2016, the Most Reverend Peter Leo Gerety, Archbishop Emeritus of Newark, entered eternal life. He was 104 and was the oldest Catholic bishop in the world! In 1974, Pope Paul VI appointed Bishop Gerety the third Archbishop of Newark and he was installed on June 28, 1974. He retired from active ministry in 1986. Reflecting on Archbishop Gerety’s 77 years of priestly and episcopal ministry, and more than a century of life, his long-time friend and fellow priest, Msgr. Frank Seymour, once wrote: “When he was ordained a bishop in 1966, he chose as his motto: ‘In omnibus Christus’ – ‘In all Things, Christ.’ As he made Christ the center of his life, he wanted to do the same for others by entering the priesthood.” May he rest in peace eternally in the loving arms of the Lord!

At our 10:30 Mass today, we express our thanks and gratitude to Barbara Dillon for her fourteen years of dedicated service in teaching the Youth and Children of our Parish. We wish her God’s Blessings in her many ministries to the Parish in the days ahead.

This Tuesday, October 4th, we will celebrate the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi. The blessing of our animals will take place Sunday at 1pm in the parking lot next to the Blessed Mother statue. All animals are welcome but... no elephants please!
