  - b. How is one condemned to hell?
  - c. What is the chief punishment of hell?
  - d. Is anyone predestined for hell? Explain.

  - a. According to verse 3, what infiltrated the earth?
  - b. Even though the locusts are small insects, they can cause great destruction. What in life can start out small but end up causing great destruction?
