

DAY 1 – REVELATION 20:1-3

1. What did you find new and/or interesting from the lecture?
2. What did the angel hold in his hand?
3. List the names given to the evil one in today's passage.
4.
 - a. What did the angel do to the devil and why?
 - b. How do you guard yourself against being led astray? **(Personal)**
5. How long was Satan detained and what does this number symbolize? (See Symbols Handout)
6.
 - a. At what point in time can it be said that Satan was seized and his power restrained? (See CCC 635, 671)
 - b. How can a person benefit from this restraint and attain liberation from Satan's power? (See CCC 1237)
 - c. Even though Satan is defeated and restrained, he still tries to attack. How do we, through our own actions, put ourselves within Satan's reach?

DAY 2 – REVELATION 20:4-6

 - a. What was entrusted to those seated upon the thrones?
 - b. To whom had a share in this power been promised? (See Mt 19:28; 1 Cor 6:2-3)
8. What had people done to merit reigning with Christ?
9.
 - a. According to the following references, to what does the "first resurrection" refer? (See Col 2:12; CCC 1002)
 - b. Why can those who share in it be called blessed and holy? (See Eph 1:3-4; CCC 823)
 - c. Why do you think the second death (hell) has no power over these? (See CCC 1263)
 - d. How do they reign with Christ? (See CCC 865)
10. A different view is that the first resurrection refers to the moment when the soul enters heaven. If so:
 - a. Why can these souls be called blessed and holy? (See CCC 1026)
 - b. Why are they not affected by the second death? (See CCC 1023)
 - c. How do they reign with Christ? (See CCC 1029)

 - b. How does Matthew 24:21-22 indicate that the elect will not be “raptured” before this final trial?
14. According to CCC 675, how will this spiritual reality come to pass in terms of the Church on earth?
15.
 - a. How many are gathered for battle with Satan?
 - b. Even though the holy ones are surrounded by an infinite army, what is the outcome?
 - c. How does CCC 677 explain this event?
16. How will Satan and his followers spend eternity?

DAY 5 – REVELATION 20:11-15

 - a. What did John see after witnessing the devil condemned to Hell?
 - b. Why did the earth and sky “flee”? (See Is 51:6; Rev 21:1)
18. Who stood before the throne?

 - a. Verse 12 refers to the resurrection of the body. What does this mean? (See CCC 997)
 - b. Who will rise? (See Jn 5:28-29)
 - c. How will the dead rise and when? (See 1 Cor 15:35-38, 42-44, 51-53; CCC 999, 1001)
20. The General/Last Judgment will immediately follow the resurrection of the dead. According to verses 12 and 13, upon what will the dead be judged?
21. What will happen at the General Judgment? (See CCC 1039)
22. What is the Particular Judgment? (See CCC 1021-1022)
