

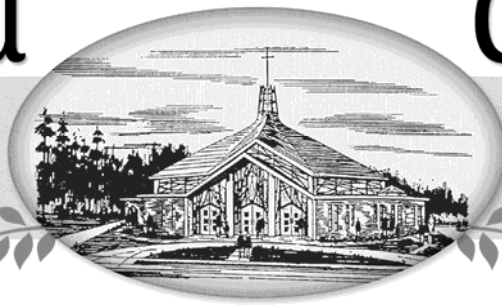

## **Message from the Pastor:**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints – a day in which the Church celebrates All Saints – those we know and those that we will never know. When the Church canonizes someone she affirms that this person has lived a life of true holiness. Jesus calls us all to holiness. By following the teachings of Jesus and the Church, celebrating in the sacraments, and trusting in the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the path to heaven is open for all of us. Our journey of faith may not be an easy one. There will be many hardships and challenges along the way. But if we walk humbly with our God, we will one day be with Him in eternal peace and joy.

In today's Gospel of Matthew we hear Jesus teaching to the disciples in the Sermon on the Mount. The Beatitudes, or eight Blessings, each consist of two phrases: a "challenge" and a "promise". The "challenge" of the Beatitudes is to embrace these ways of living and thus make present in the "here and now" God's reign. The "promise" of the Beatitudes is that certain ways of living (poor in spirit, meek, merciful, peacemakers, etc.) will lead to inheriting a place in the heavenly kingdom. While the Beatitudes are a challenging blueprint for Christian living, they are not an impossible goal. We all know people who have fruitfully taken up the challenge of the Beatitudes and thus inspire us to saintly living.

Monday, Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup> we commemorate All Souls Day. In addition to our two earlier Masses at 8am and Noon, we will have a special Mass of Remembrance at 7pm. We will pray on this day, and all during the month of November, for all souls, and especially those who have passed away this year from our Parish and for those remembered on the All Souls envelopes.

I would like to acknowledge and welcome our new Lectors for the readings at our Masses. They have gone through formal training at our Archdiocese and are ready to take on this new Ministry which is such an important part of our Liturgy. Please keep them in your prayers and wish them well as they go forward and serve our Lord and our Parish:

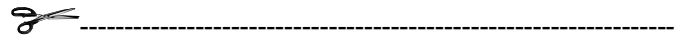

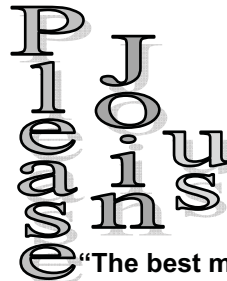
