

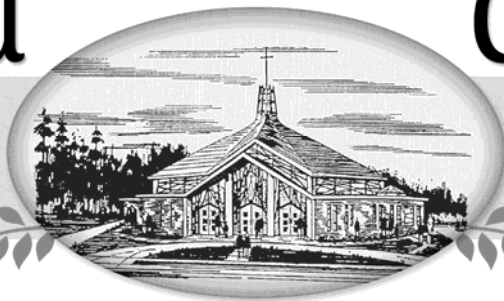

Message from the Pastor:

The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

What kind of King is Jesus? In John's Gospel today, Jesus provides us with His own answer. Pontius Pilate asks Jesus if He is the King of the Jews. Pilate really wants to know whether Jesus might be part of a Jewish revolt against Roman rule. Jesus assures Pilate that His kingdom is not of this world. He is not one who rules by power and force. He is a King who came into the world "to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

As the Church year comes to a close, and we look ahead to Advent beginning next Sunday, we are thankful for the ways we have heard the voice of Jesus Christ, our King, in our lives. As the new liturgical year begins, let us continue to keep Him close to us in all that we do.

This Thursday, Nov.26th we celebrate Thanksgiving Day. As you sit down for dinner with your families and friends let us say this special prayer for everything that we have to be thankful for.

***Father, all of Creation rightly owes you thanks and praise.
We thank you this day for all that you have given us:
For our loved ones and friends who have gone before us...
their love abides with us forever.

they are your precious gift to us and to the world.
For the gift of our families, loved ones and good friends...
through them we see the reflection of your Son.

Centennial Tidbits

2015-2016

The first mass in the church named Immaculate Heart of Mary took place on May 14, 1916. Ground breaking for the new Church was August 15, 1987. Last Mass in the old Church was July 30, 1989. For a brief time both churches stood side by side (less than 10 feet part). In early August, 1989 the old church was razed. Dedication Day for our current church was September 24, 1989.
