

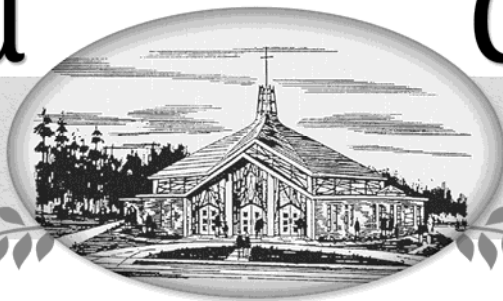

Message from the Pastor:

“In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.”

Today, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, the Scriptures call for reflection on this central belief of Christianity: the Trinity. One of the greatest gifts of the Christian faith is the dogma of the triune God: God is three (tri) in one (une). Christians name God as a Trinity of Father, Son, and Spirit, but only in light of Jesus Christ does such language and insight fully emerge.

In the Gospel of John today, Jesus continues with advice and instructions to the disciples at the Last Supper. He promises that the Spirit will be there to guide his followers to the truth – the gift of the Spirit of truth who will enlighten them on all that Jesus said and did while He was with them. The Spirit will guide and enlighten them on those things they find difficult to understand and bear. The Spirit will speak in Jesus' name, just as Jesus speaks in the Father's name. Each of these three Persons in one God belongs to the other. We call this mystery of God's identity the Blessed Trinity. This Solemnity presents the Trinity as a mystery not to be “solved” or “explained,” but as a Trinity of Persons who share their very Life with us. We are a community intimately united to God through Jesus Christ by the work of the Spirit gifted to us. Today, we celebrate this rich love relationship which is ours in our Trinitarian God!

This month, on May 28th, ten men will be ordained priests of the Archdiocese of Newark by Archbishop John J. Myers at the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart. Please keep these men in your prayers as they go forth to share the light and love of Christ to all God's people in their new ministries and all the days of their lives.

I, again, want to thank everyone – both staff and volunteers – too many to name - who contributed their time, talents, and generosity in all our recent events – from our First Communion, Confirmation, the “We are Living Stones” campaign receptions, and last weekend, the 100th Anniversary Jubilee receptions and the Crowning of our Blessed Mother – in making them such a success! It's ALL OF YOU that make our Parish the warm, loving and welcoming home that it is for our families, visitors and the community – in the past, the here and now, and as we go forward and embark on the days ahead! And, please mark your calendars - I just got word that Bishop Paul G. Bootkoski, originally Priest and Bishop of our Archdiocese, and who has just recently retired as Bishop of Metuchen Diocese, will join us for the closing of our Jubilee Year events, celebrating the Noon Mass here on Sunday, September 25th. More to follow on this special occasion for our Parish!

As we also continue in this Jubilee Year of Mercy, I'd like to close with a quote from Pope Francis as he spoke to the pilgrims in St. Peter's Square on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity last year. He said: “We are not called to live without the other, above or against the other, but with the other, for the other and in the other. THIS – the Pope said - means welcoming and bearing witness to the beauty of the Gospel; loving each other, sharing joy and suffering, learning how to forgive.” Let us try to live THIS each and every day of our life!

What is a Christogram?

— a combination of letters that represent the holy name "Jesus." Early scribes would abbreviate the sacred name of Jesus by using the first two letters of the name, with a line over the letters. I (iota) and H (eta) are the first two Greek letters for "Jesus." Sometime in the second century, the third letter, S (sigma), was added, thereby rendering IHS. Fr. William P. Saunders
