

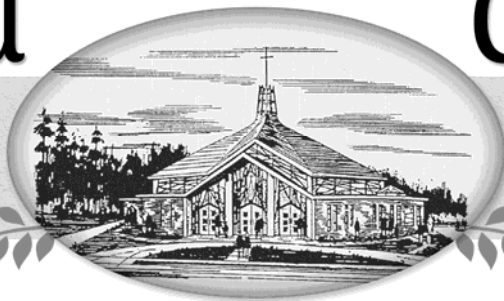

Message from the Pastor:

***Please Join our Parish Community on Sunday, September 25th –
A Special Day in our History!***

In case you were away, or missed last week's Bulletin, there are flyers in the Church vestibule on our upcoming **100th Jubilee Closing Celebration on Sunday, Sept. 25th**! We will begin the day in prayer and sacrifice with the **Noon Mass**. Bishop Paul Bootkoski, who was ordained in Newark and retired from the Diocese of Metuchen, will be the main celebrant. The day will continue with a **Gala Buffet at 2pm at the Sheraton Hotel in Mahwah**. **Registration forms must be completed** and dropped off at the Rectory or placed in Collection Basket by **Sept. 9th**. I know everyone is looking forward to this special day - it truly will be a day to commemorate and salute our history, celebrate all that we are today, and to ask for God's Blessings and guidance for all the days of tomorrow! As we try to stay cool during these last "stifling" days of summer let us keep in our prayers our Young Adults who are preparing, or have already gone off, to college. Labor Day is just two weeks away and our children will also be getting ready to go back to school. **So please don't forget to mark your calendars - beginning on Sunday, Sept. 18 at 6pm, and every Sunday thereafter**, we will have a special **Youth Mass** with a **Social Hour following!** Additionally, **Last Call for Religious Education Registration** is now!

As our Young Adults and Children prepare for this next school year let us not forget the message of Pope Francis from his closing Mass at WTD: "We can say that World Youth Day begins today and continues tomorrow, in your homes, since that is where Jesus wants to meet you from now on. The Lord doesn't want to remain in this beautiful city, or in cherished memories alone. He wants to enter your homes, to dwell in your daily lives: in your studies, your first years of work, your friendships and affections, your hopes and dreams. How greatly He desires that you bring all this to Him in prayer! How much He hopes that, in all the "contacts" and "chats" of each day, pride of place be given to the golden thread of prayer! How much He wants His word to be able to speak to you day after day, so that you can make his Gospel your own, so that it can serve as a compass for you on the highways of life!" In the first reading today, Isaiah prophesied that salvation is offered to people from all nations. The Gospel of Luke, however, makes clear a condition for salvation: those who desire salvation must journey with Jesus to Jerusalem and accept all this entails. The narrow road to salvation will not be easy; often difficult and demanding. But the strength needed to persist on this journey comes from God Himself and His Saving Grace for us all!

I also want to advise everyone that I have just be notified by Archbishop John J. Myers that I have been appointed Temporary Administrator of Immaculate Conception Parish in Mahwah while remaining Pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, effective August 17th, 2016. I ask for all your prayers and support especially during this interim period in the days ahead!

The Feast Day of Our Lady of Czestochowa.

For Polish Catholics, 26 August marks the feast day of Our Lady of Czestochowa. The shrine on the Warta River in South Central Poland is on a hill called Jasna Gora. It is here that Mary is honored by Polish people throughout the world as the Queen of Poland. Tradition says that St. Ladislaus determined to save the image from repeated invasions, stopped to rest in Czestochowa. The image was brought nearby to Jasna Gora and placed in a small church for safe keeping. The following morning, when the picture was ready to be moved, the horses refused to move. St. Ladislaus understood this to be a sign from Heaven that the image should stay in Czestochowa; so the painting remained in the Church of the Assumption. He assigned the church to the Pauline Fathers, who have devoutly protected the image for the last six hundred years.

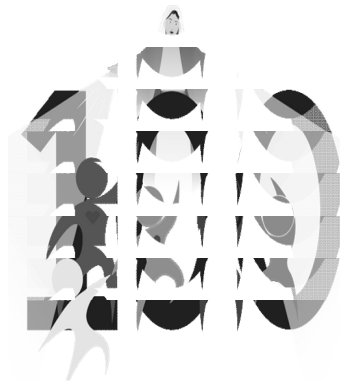
