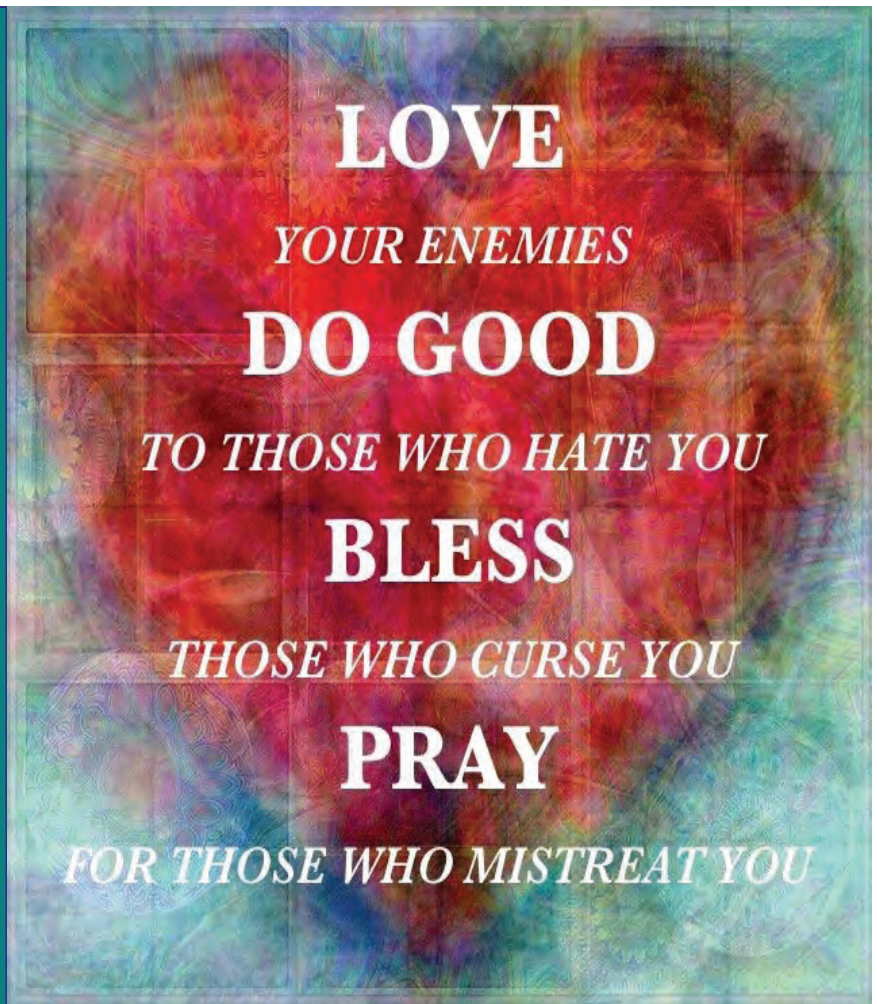

Message from the Pastor:

At the end of the Sermon on the Mount in today's Gospel of Matthew, Jesus uses two more examples of the Mosaic law to continue his new interpretation of the law. Both relate to difficult relationships that the disciples, and us, might experience. They include relations with people who strike us, people who ask for help, and people we consider to be our enemies. This teaching is not one of the easier ones to accept; it calls on the disciples to rethink both the social customs of the time and the intent of the religious law. Jesus asks them, and us, to go beyond what might be an easy response to one that would be more compassionate and life giving. As challenging as they are, His examples of this "beyond" are nonetheless still finite human actions and limited love. Jesus' examples are shocking but not nearly so shocking as what He really expects of us: "be perfect" as our "heavenly Father," who gives Life - "sun rise" and "rain" - to the "just and the unjust" alike. Infinite actions. Limitless love. What a challenge for us all in this world today!

With Lent a week and a half away we have decided to launch *Sharing God's Blessings Annual Appeal 2017* this weekend. The *Annual Appeal* is a way to raise money to fund the programs and ministries of the Archdiocese of Newark that impact tens of thousands of lives every year. Our Parish receives a portion of the funds raised in achieving our goal. Our Parish's goal this year is \$32,800. There is a more detailed write-up later in this Bulletin. Your generous support of the *Annual Appeal* is so needed in helping those less fortunate than ourselves as Jesus talked about in today's Gospel. Help us be that beacon of light for all our brothers and sisters in need!

Speaking of Lent, Ash Wednesday is next week, March 1st. Hard to believe it will soon be here but when the end of February and the beginning of March are upon us we know it is a sign of Spring not too far ahead. Crocuses begin to pop up followed by the daffodils, spring rains wash away the dirt and grime of the winter snows, the time changes back to daylight savings time (Sunday, March 12th) but more importantly, this year, we begin our own personal Lenten Journey to prepare for the glorious celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord on Easter. Please stay tuned next week for all our Lenten activities that will help us renew our own personal encounter with Jesus. The schedule for Ash Wednesday is as follows: Masses with distribution of ashes: 8am, 12noon, 6pm, 7:30 (Polish); ash service only: 3pm and 4pm.

On Monday, Feb. 20th, (Presidents' Day) we are planning a ski trip to Campgaw Mt. for our altar servers (weather permitting). Please pray for us that we have a wonderful and safe day.

I wish you all a wonderful and safe week as well. Enjoy the three-day weekend!

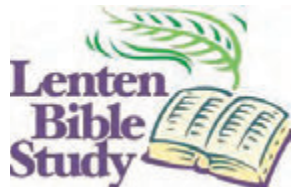

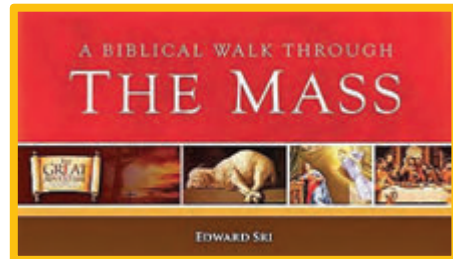

The Lenten Season will soon be upon us in a little more than a week. Please mark your calendars and join us for 5 weekly sessions through Lent on A BIBLICAL WALK THROUGH THE MASS.

The Mass is the celebration of the Eucharist that Christ instituted at the Last Supper. From the time of the apostles, the Mass has been the central act of Christian worship. As Catholics, the Mass is the center of our Faith. We celebrate it every day. We know all the responses. We know all the gestures. **But do we understand it and know what it all means?**

Through prayer, readings, video presentations by Dr. Edward Sri, and group discussions and sharing, we will explore the words and gestures we experience in the Liturgy and gain an enriched understanding of their profound significance.

Dr. Edward Sri is a theologian, author and well-known Catholic speaker who appears regularly on EWTN. He has written several Catholic best-selling books, including *A Biblical Walk through the Mass* which was used in many parishes in the US in preparation for the new translation of the Mass. His most recent books are *Love Unveiled: The Catholic Faith Explained* and *Walking with Mary: A Biblical Journey from Nazareth to the Cross*.

MOVIE REVIEW – LION

The incredible true story of Saroo Brierley (Dev Patel) and his 20-year odyssey to locate his birth mother (Priyanka Bose) in India, is retold in this uplifting and emotional film, directed by Garth Davis. As a 5-year-old boy, Saroo (Sunny Pawar) falls asleep in a boxcar and is transported 1,500 kilometers from home. Unable to remember his family name and home village, he is put up for adoption, and winds up in Australia in the care of a loving couple (Nicole Kidman and David Wenham). Yet, as he grows into manhood with a promising career and a girlfriend (Rooney Mara), he is haunted by his lost childhood, and sets out on an epic quest to retrace his long-ago train journey and locate his relatives. A celebration of family, the movie also sends a strong pro-life message by underscoring the joys and merits of adoption, and showing that a child can be loved and shared equally by two sets of parents. Unfortunately, the elements listed below preclude endorsement for younger viewers who might otherwise have profited from this touching narrative. Mature themes and two brief nongraphic nonmarital sex scenes. The Catholic News Service classification is A-III -- adults. The Motion Picture Association of America rating is PG-13 -- parents strongly cautioned. Some material may be inappropriate for children under 13.

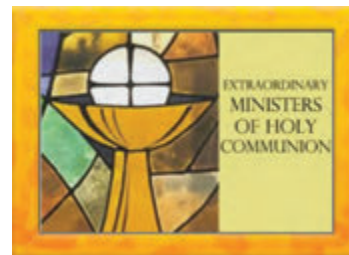
