**"Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also.  
For this purpose have I come."**

In today's Gospel of Mark Jesus' healing of Peter's mother-in-law was very personal: He approached her, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Further, in reaching out to "the whole of Galilee" Jesus responds to the universal human condition of misery and hopelessness. But He always does so in a very personal way. The ministry of Jesus is truly about all humanity's experiencing the transformation of human hopelessness through personal encounter with Jesus.

In the First Reading, Job describes the misery of the human condition when he laments that his life is filled with "drudgery" - he feels trapped - "is a slave" and is "without hope." This also describes the condition of the people who came to Jesus for healing. Jesus overturns the human condition, bringing hope and healing - then and now!

As noted last week, this weekend we will launch the Archdiocese of Newark's "Sharing God's Blessings 2018 Annual Appeal" campaign "One Body...One Mission". Please think about this interesting video presentation we will see at all Masses today along with the materials we will distribute on the good works that this appeal goes to throughout our Archdiocese. We recognize that everyone has their own unique life circumstances and only you can decide what gift is right for you, your family and your budget. Last year our goal was \$32,857; pledges totaled \$25,185; total amount received was \$24,935, 75.89% of our goal. In order to receive a Parish rebate, we need to exceed 100% of our goal. This year our goal is \$32,126. As Jesus did in today's Gospel, let us pray and "go on to the nearby villages" and help our fellow man as our means permit.

Next weekend the Church celebrates World Marriage Day. This special day celebrates the gift and blessing of marriage and affirms and supports all married couples. All married couples will receive a special Blessing at all Masses and those married 25+ years will receive a rose in honor of their commitment to God and each other.

Also mentioned last week Lent is just around the corner. Please mark for calendars on these important dates for our Lenten Missions. Polish: Ash Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, evening, February 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm with Fr. Michał Olszewski; English: Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup> at the 5pm Mass, all Sunday Masses and Monday through Wednesday, February 19<sup>th</sup> to February 21<sup>st</sup> at 7pm with the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal from Newburgh, NY. I assure you, both of these retreat leaders, along with musicians, will help us prepare on our personal journey with Jesus this Lent. Please see more information with-in this Bulletin. And, please, don't miss them! You won't regret it!

### SEVEN SUNDAYS OF DEVOTION TO ST. JOSEPH

*Beginning today, Sunday, February 4<sup>th</sup>, and each of the seven weeks thereafter, a Sunday Devotion to St. Joseph will be featured in the Bulletin.*



This devotion is said to have started when two Franciscan monks, who were ship wrecked at sea, clung to a plank for two days and were saved by a man of venerable appearance who miraculously brought them to shore. When they asked who he was, he replied, "I am Joseph, and I desire you to honor my seven sorrows and seven joys." It is through these Seven Sundays of Devotion that we can do precisely that. Let us offer these prayers each Sunday to honor St. Joseph as we prepare for his Feast Day on Monday, March 19<sup>th</sup>.



### SEVEN SORROWS AND JOYS OF ST. JOSEPH

#### First Sunday - February 4

*Chaste Lover of Mary, how overwhelmed you were when you thought that you would have to end your betrothal to her. But when the angel of God came to you in a dream, you were filled with awe to realize that Mary would be your wife, and you would be the guardian of the Messiah.*

*Help us St. Joseph, help our families and all our loved ones to overcome all sadness of heart and develop an absolute trust in God's goodness.*

(Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be.)

*O blessed St. Joseph, tenderhearted father, faithful guardian of Jesus, chaste spouse of the Mother of God, I pray and beseech you to offer to God the Father my praise to Him through his divine Son, who died on the cross and rose again to give us sinners new life. Through the holy name of Jesus, pray with us that we may obtain from the eternal Father, the favor we ask . . . (Pause) . . . We have been unfaithful to the unfailing love of God the Father; beg of Jesus mercy for us. Amid the splendors of God's loving presence, do not forget the sorrows of those who suffer, those who pray, those who weep. By your prayers and those of your most holy spouse, our Blessed Lady, may the love of Jesus answer our call of confident hope. Amen.*

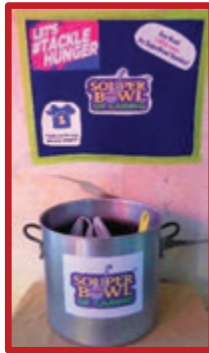
